"Accomplished Principal Dr. P. Anil Kumar Contributes as Diligent NAAC Peer Evaluator "



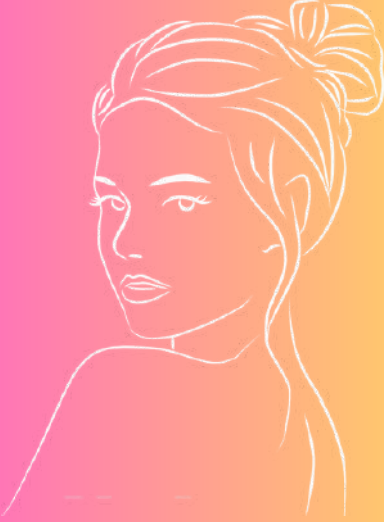

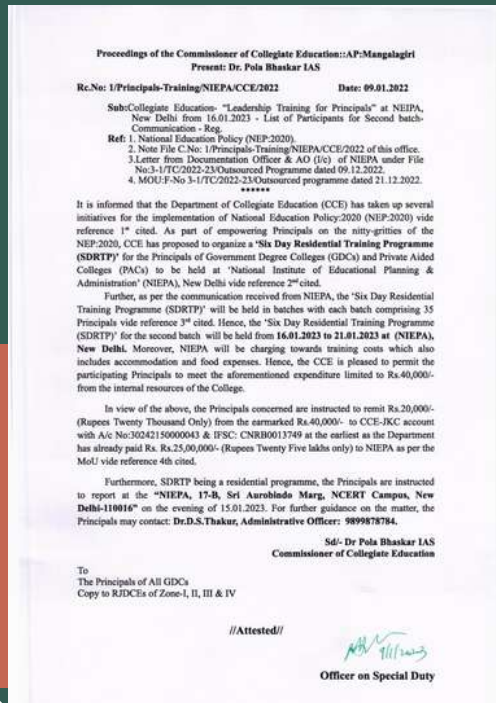
Contribution of Dual-Desks by Rotary club

Admission campaigning

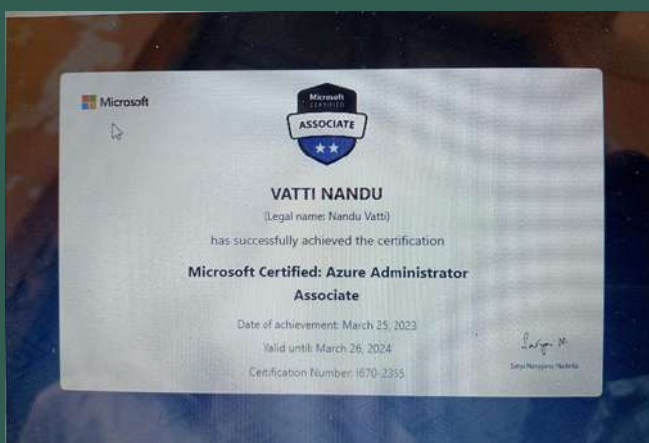
27 March 2023

07.03.2023

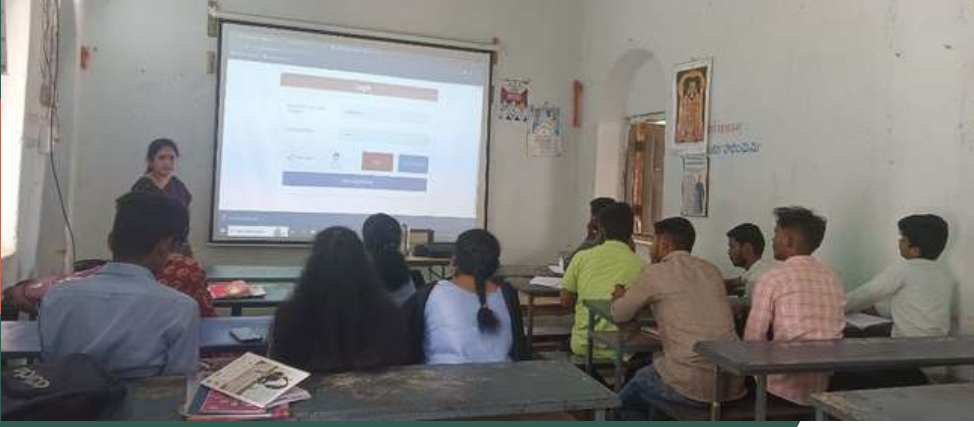

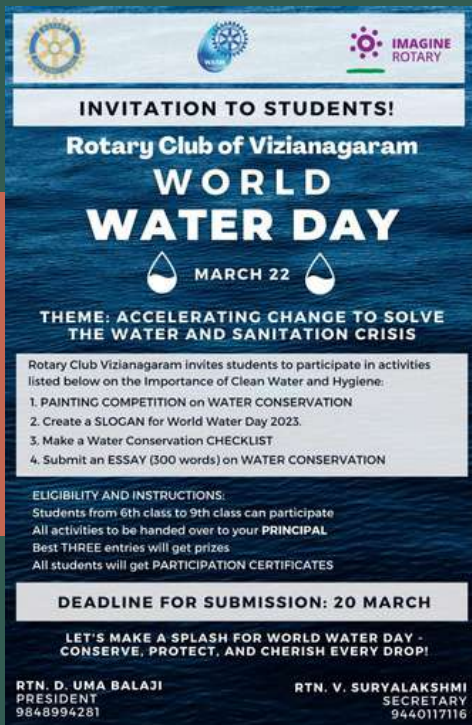
Smart India Hackathon -2022
