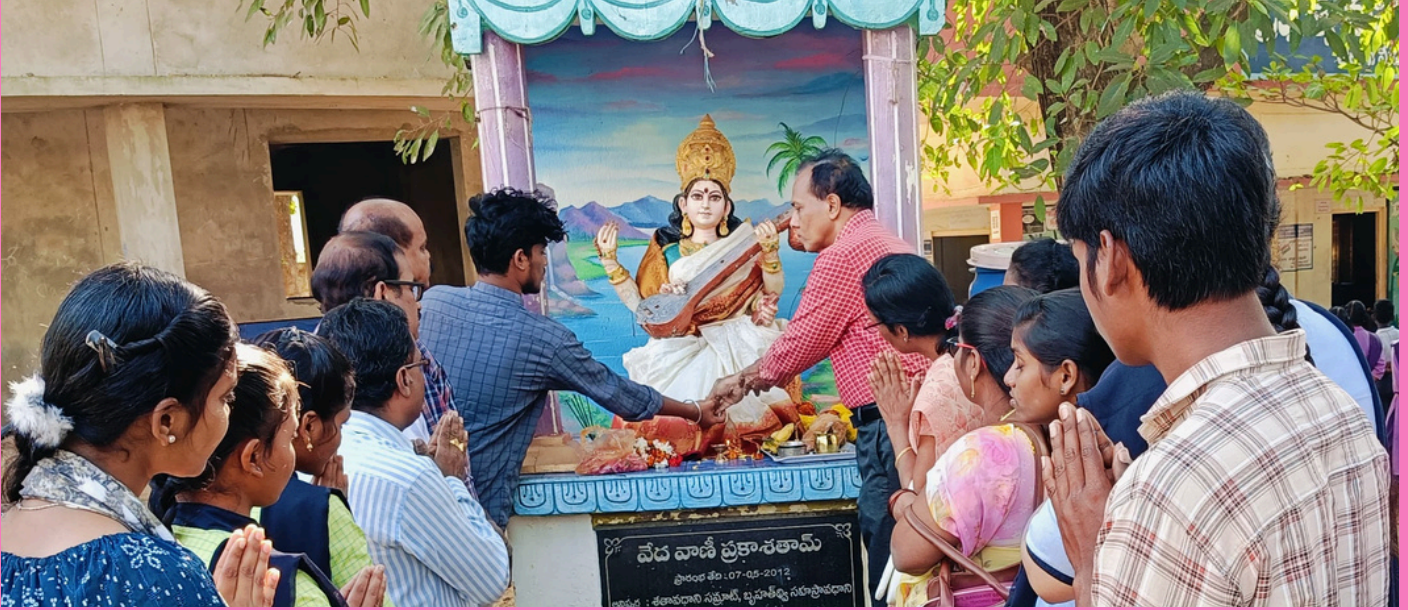

  - P. Prasad, II B.Sc. Computer Science


**Objectives of the Club:**
