07.01.2026

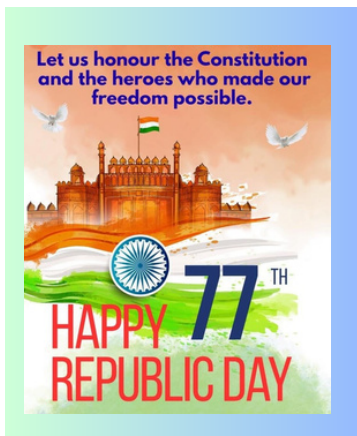

26 Jan 2026



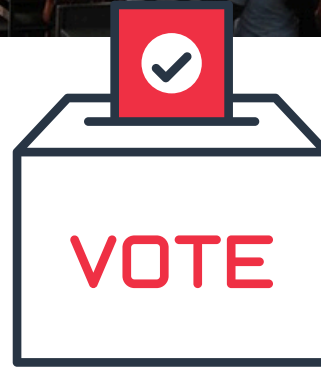

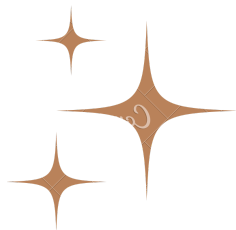
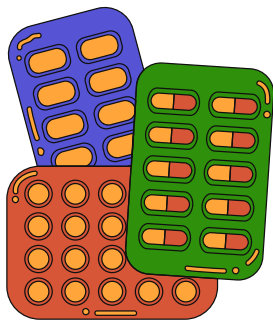




DISTRIBUTION OF IRON TABLETS

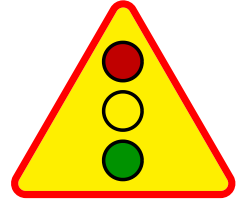


THE DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF MAHATMA GANDHI
