RENDZUOUS WITH NEW M.L.A 07 JUNE 2024

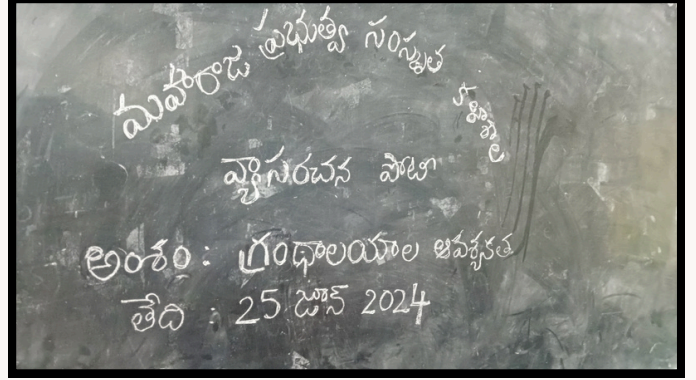

MY BHARAT PORTAL REGISTRATION

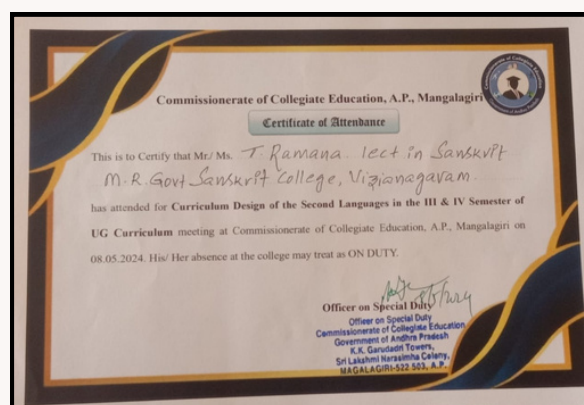
