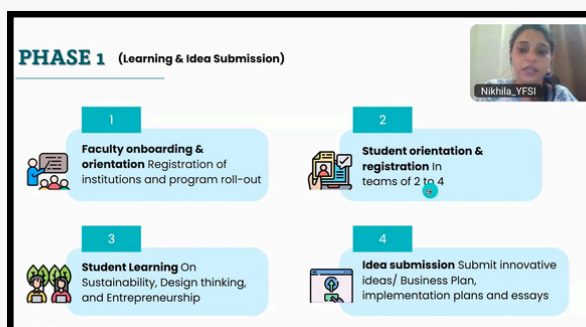
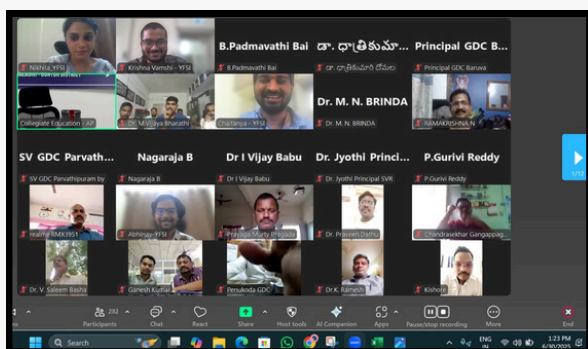
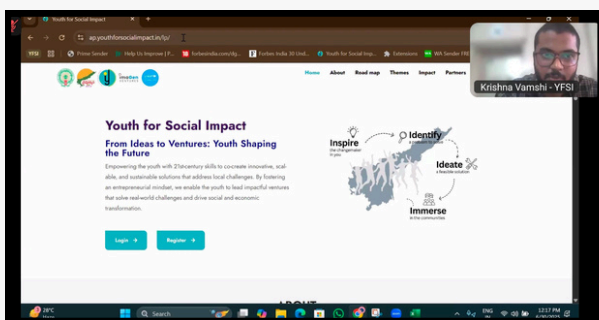
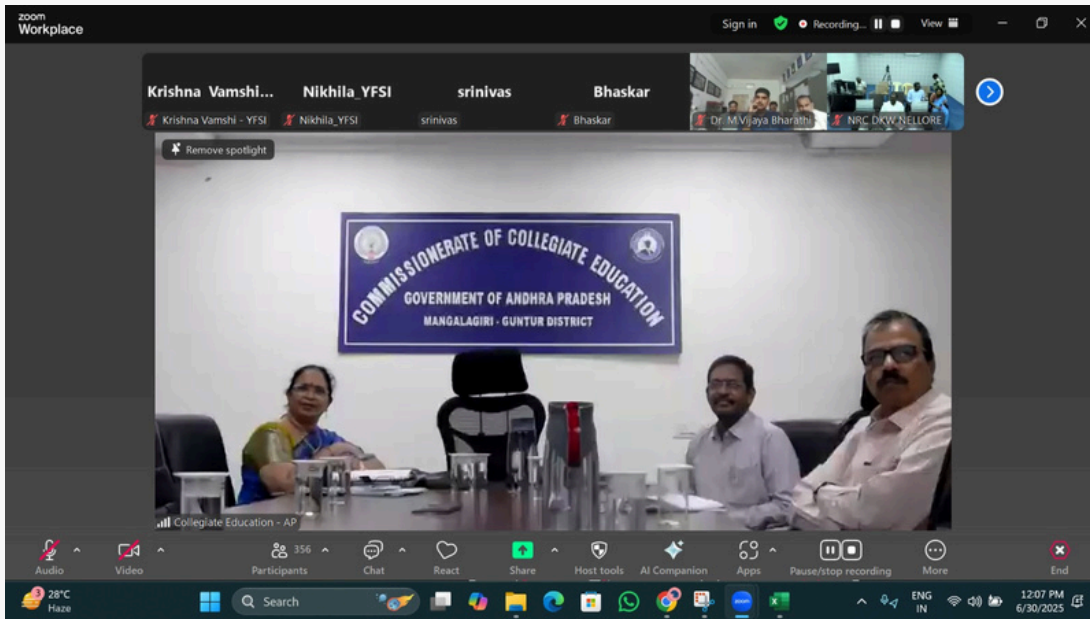
KARMAYOGI BHARATH CERTIFICATION
