SUMMER CAMPAIGN FOR PDC ADMISSIONS

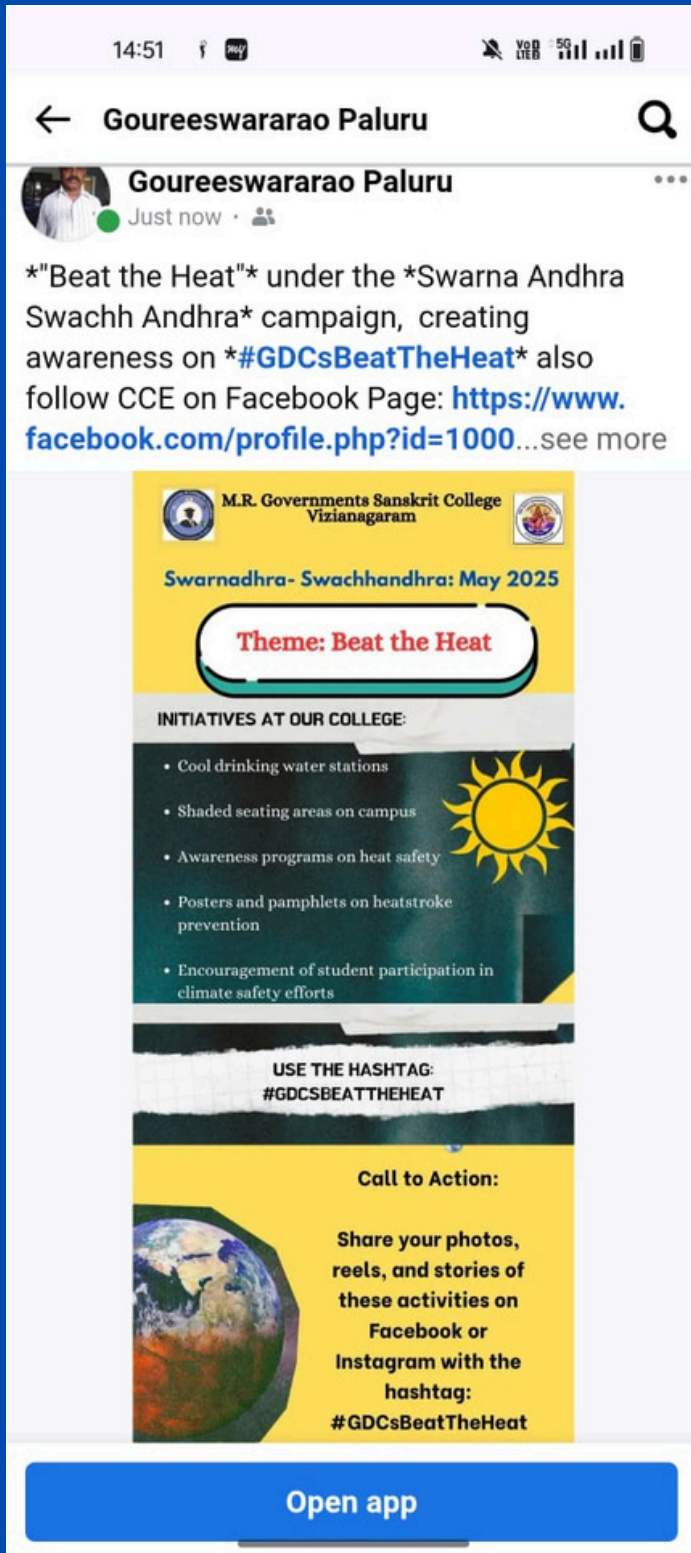

BEAT THE HEAT: A CAMPAIGN

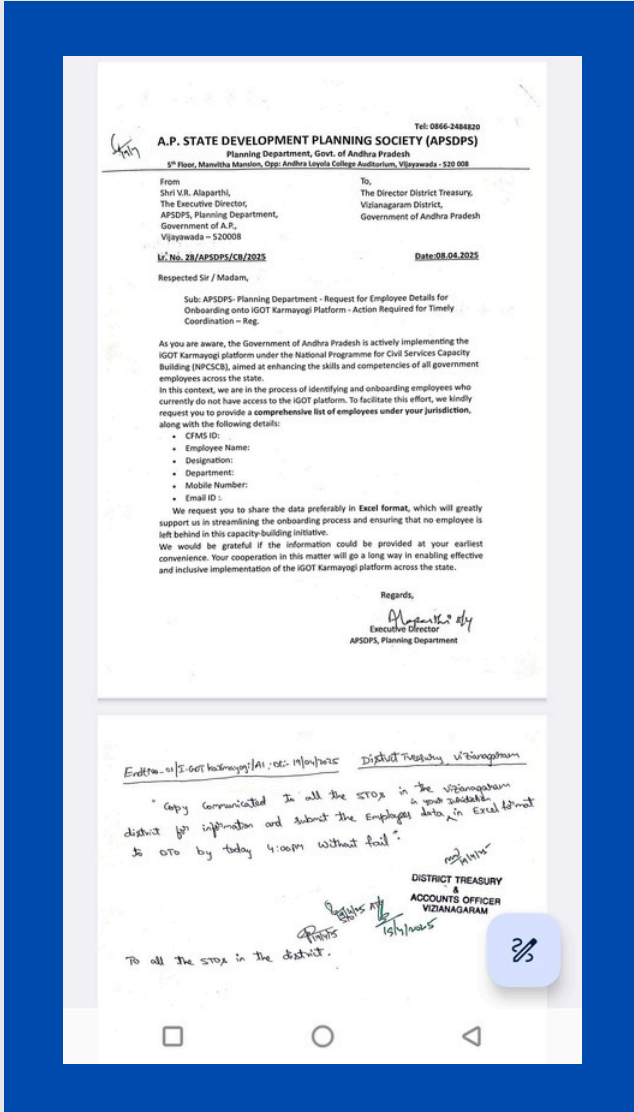

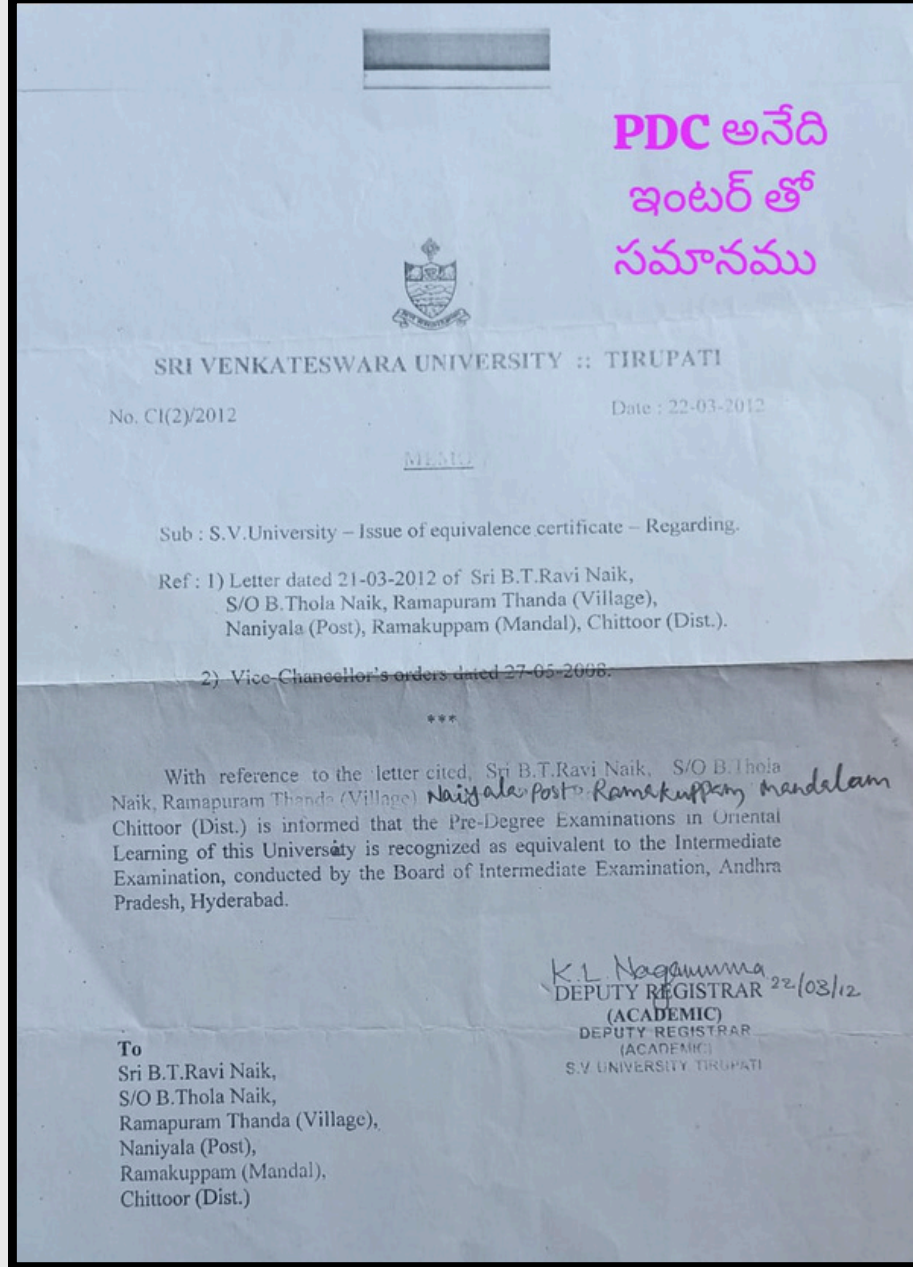
IGOT KARMAYOGI MAY 2025

PDC EQUIVALENT TO INTERMEDIATE
